

**Side 4 Lion(Z), Scarecrow(Hu), Dorothy, Doorman(UH), Tin Man(Hi)**

LION. That's one scary door.

SCARECROW. Don't be silly, how can a door be scary?

LION. How can you know what's on the other side??

SCARECROW. Don't be ridiculous!

LION. Don't call me that.

DOROTHY. Stop it you two. There's a bell here, and I'm gonna ring it

LION. Don't touch that!

DOROTHY. Why not?

LION. Because you... Oh no she rang it.

*DOROTHY has indeed rung the bell. UNCLE HENRY as a DOORMAN appears, furiously at an opening high up.*

DOORMAN. Who rang the bell?

LION. She did.

DOORMAN. You can't do that!

LION. You see!

SCARECROW. Why not?

DOORMAN. Can't you read?

SCARECROW. Erm...

TIN MAN. Read what?

DOORMAN. The notice!

ALL 4. What notice?

DOORMAN. The one on the door—as plain as the nose on my face! It's..oh...Don't go away.

*The DOORMAN disappears, re-appearing with a notice which he hangs on the door.*

DOORMAN. There you are. Now read that!

ALL 4. Bell out of order. Please knock!

**DOORMAN.** It must have dropped off. Go on.

**LION.** ...Go on what?

**DOORMAN.** *(fed up)* What it says. Go on, then.

*The DOORMAN gives a patronizing knocking motion before disappearing again. TIN MAN uses his axe to knock loudly. The DOORMAN reappears.*

**DOORMAN.** That's more like it. Now state your business in Emerald City.

**ALL 4.** We want to see the Wizard.

**DOORMAN.** The Wizard?

**ALL 4.** Yes.

**DOORMAN.** But nobody can see the Great Oz! No one's ever seen the Great Oz! Not nobody not no-how. Even I've never seen him, not in the flesh.

**DOROTHY.** Well, then... How do you know he exists?

**DOORMAN.** Don't get metaphysical on me, honey! Be on your way.

**DOROTHY.** Oh please! Please Sir, I've got to see the Wizard. Glinda the Good Witch of the North sent me!

**DOORMAN.** Prove it.

**SCARECROW.** She's wearing the ruby slippers.

**DOROTHY.** Look.

**LION.** Check 'em out!

**DOORMAN.** Oh my, so she is! The slippers of legend. Well, bust my buttons! You should have told me that in the first place! That's a horse of a different color.

**SCARECROW.** Did he say horse?
